Materials Used for Folk Art Birdhouses

- saw for cutting out bird forms
- 4' x 8' 1/4" plywood for the bird cut-outs
- acrylic paint
- empty, clean, soup cans; one for each student
- 36" (90 cm) baling twine for each bird-house
- goop for gluing the bird form to the soup can
- tacky glue
- feathers, sequins, buttons, other notions
- paint pens; one set for three to four students to share
- glitter glue of various colors
- colored markers, including metallic silver
- drawing paper
- colored pencils
